# Recommendations

Expert analysis of your NCAA eligibility position

! Physical Education (Units 1 & 2) is classified non-core and does not count toward your NCAA core GPA.

! VET Sport & Recreation does not meet NCAA core-course requirements and has been excluded.

## GPA COMMENTARY

**01** Alex's current core GPA of 2.59 clears the Division I minimum of 2.3 with room to spare. The strongest results are in English and the sciences; the General Mathematics and Economics results (both C, 2.0) are the main drag on the average. Lifting maths in Year 12 is the single highest-leverage move available.

## CLASSES THAT DIDN'T COUNT

**02** Two completed subjects did not count toward the core GPA: Physical Education (Units 1 & 2) and VET Sport & Recreation. Both are valuable subjects, but neither is recognised as NCAA core academic content. They are shown in the Non-Core section for completeness.

## ELIGIBILITY SUMMARY

**03** On track for Division I, II and NAIA. Alex has 11 of the 16 required core credits completed with a passing core GPA, and the 10/7 early-completion rule is currently satisfied. The remaining 5 core credits must be earned in Year 12 — see the plan below.

## ADDITIONAL COURSES

**04** To reach 16 core credits, Year 12 should include: English (Units 3 & 4), a Mathematics sequence (Units 3 & 4), and at least two more Additional Core academic subjects such as Economics, History, or a Science. Avoid replacing an academic subject with a non-core elective this year.

# How to Read This Report

A quick guide to NCAA and NAIA eligibility

## ELIGIBILITY PATHWAYS

## NCAA Division I

16 core courses across Years 9–12, minimum 2.3 core GPA. 10 of the 16 must be completed before the start of Year 12, and 7 of those 10 must be in English, Maths, or Science (the “10/7 rule”). Once Year 12 begins, those grades are locked.

## NCAA Division III

No NCAA-wide academic standard. Each Division III college sets its own admission criteria, and there is no Eligibility Center certification required.

## NCAA Division II

16 core courses across Years 9–12, minimum 2.2 core GPA. There is no early-completion rule, so courses can be finished any time before enrolment.

## NAIA

A separate body from the NCAA. Automatic eligibility with a 2.3+ GPA, otherwise the student must meet two of three: 2.0+ GPA, 18 ACT / 970 SAT, or top half of graduating class.

## HOW GPA IS CALCULATED

Each grade is converted to a 4.0 scale (A = 4, B = 3, C = 2, D = 1, F = 0), weighted by credit value, and averaged across all core courses. Only core courses count toward the NCAA core GPA. Non-core subjects are shown for reference but do not affect eligibility.

### Core courses

Academic subjects in English, Maths (Algebra I or higher), Natural/Physical Science, Social Science, languages other than English, or Comparative Religion/Philosophy. Must be taught at or above the school’s standard academic level.

### Non-core courses

Subjects like PE, Health, the Arts, vocational/applied courses, and remedial classes. These do not count toward the core GPA but are shown so the full transcript is visible.

## WHAT EACH SECTION SHOWS

### Summary & Eligibility

Headline numbers and pass/fail checks against each division’s GPA, core-course count, and the 10/7 rule.

### Recommendations

Plain-English commentary on the GPA, classes that did not count, the eligibility position, and any waiver pathway.

### Core Course Breakdown

Each core subject grouped by NCAA category (English, Maths, Science, Social Science, etc.), showing how many credits have been earned in each area against the requirement.

### Detailed Analysis

Every subject the student has taken, grouped by year and semester, with the grade, GPA equivalent, credit value, and core/non-core status.

## NOTES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- Plus and minus modifiers are ignored. Grades of B+, B, and B- all count as a 3.0.
- Core credits are assigned by NCAA value (full-year subjects = 1.0, semester subjects = 0.5), not by the school’s local credit system.
- Only coursework taken between Years 9 and 12 counts. Earlier study does not contribute, even if it appears on the transcript.
- Final eligibility is decided by the NCAA Eligibility Center after reviewing the official transcript and the school’s approved core-courses list.
